**Religious Education:** Our topics this term will include finishing Life Choices (with a focus on the Sacrament of Marriage) and Hope (the Advent topic). There will be a Key Stage Two online Carol Service, but due to Covid this will be in video form and sent out at the end of term.

**Mathematical Understanding:** This term we will focus on Multiplication and Division, Area and Perimeter and Statistics. The children will also look at Roman Numerals as they were used during Tudor times. We will be following the White Rose programme and practising mental maths on a daily basis. **English:** In the second half term, much of our work will be based around the Tudors. We will be writing a newspaper report about Anne Boleyn's death and learning about Tudor riddles. We will be debating whether or not Anne deserved her fate and writing a playscript. Spelling and Grammar will be linked to the Year 5 National Curriculum objectives but will involve some revision of skills. A key area for revision is homophones, plurals and use of apostrophes. **Topic:** During this half term we will be learning all about the Tudors. We will be focusing on Henry VIII and his six wives and looking at the way an individual can change the course of history (i.e: Henry's break with Rome.) Our key text for this topic will be **Treason** by Berlie Doherty and this will be used for Guided Reading sessions as well as for understanding the Tudor Court. **Science:** This term we will be learning about **Forces** in which we will find out about Isaac Newton's 3 Laws of Motion and investigate some hypotheses. The children will be learning about measuring in Newtons and the effect of different forces on movement.
